Mark and the SIM program team,  
I am pleased to see that of the 5 measures our CT school based health center teams are testing in a national quality initiative for SBHC-specific National Performance Measures, all 5 measures are included in your listing. We are testing: annual well child exams, annual depression screening for youth 12 yrs or greater, annual chlamydia screening for sexually-active youth, annual risk assessment, and annual BMI assessment and nutrition/physical activity counseling in students 3-20 years of age. These were selected through a yearlong Rand Delphi process drawn from several nationally recognized measure sets. The challenge in reporting on some of these measures is how they were entered into the EHR. For example, a depression screen is regularly conducted during a risk assessment, but the results may not be entered as a separate result in the record, so extracting it as a separate measure is difficult. Moving forward, the data required in the measures sets will need to be entered in accordance with the desired report.
